

# Installation Guide - Swimming Pool Covers

## Installation Guide: Leaf Net Pool Covers for In-ground Pools



- Place the leaf net over your pool, ensuring it rests on the water surface and extends over the pool deck by approximately 2 feet.
  - Fill each water tube with water.
  - Insert the filled water tubes into the Velcro straps provided along the edge of the cover.
  - Fasten each water tube with a Velcro strap, securing the cover to the pool deck.
  - Make sure the water tubes cover the entire perimeter of the net to prevent wind from infiltrating underneath and causing it to billow or flap.
- In regions with extreme cold, fill the water tubes only halfway to accommodate ice expansion.

**Caution:** Billowing or flapping of the cover in windy conditions may result in severe damage to the leaf net. Ensure the water tubes are placed end to end, as shown.

## Swimming Pool Safety Precautions to Prevent Injury or Drowning

- Be aware that this is an anti-leaf cover, not a safety cover.
- Keep children away from the pool cover.
- The pool cover is not designed to bear any weight.
- Properly secure the pool cover to avoid potential hazards.
- It is recommended not to walk on the pool cover or use it for support.
